



A Reflection on the Third Sunday of Easter By Deacon John Kren

He is Risen! He is Risen! Alleluia, Alleluia. After that dreadful Friday they had scattered -- but last week somehow found each other again and joined together in the upper room. The Lord appears, His voice alive: "Peace be with you". But they must have still had doubts and Thomas was not there. Now even a week later, they were still in that room, Thomas too. Again from the middle of the room, His voice alive: "Peace be with you". They put their fingers into the nail holes and their hands into His side. They are witnesses to the Risen Christ, to His signs and miracles, to his teaching. Their lives altered forever by an encounter with the Risen Jesus. They were soon called to put on Christ as we who have been baptized. They returned to Galilee, waiting, as they were told.

Peter is joined by six others, seven apostles to do the work of the boat. Here again is a charcoal fire, Jesus feeds His Church inviting them into the communion of a meal and installs Peter as the Head of the Church not because of his talent and leadership but because of Peter's love. Peter was given the pastoral role that now associates him with the Good Shepard. Jesus says feed my little ones as I have feed you. Tend my sheep as I have not lost any that the Father has given me. Feed my Church all because you love me! That is our task too as disciples, when you love me fully and completely, you give everything that I have given you, so that your fate is no longer your own. Peter's future and those who follow Christ are but a logical consequence of being like Christ.

In the Pascal Mystery we encounter the Risen Lord from the altar, Jesus, fully present in the elements of bread and wine. As disciples we have walked the Easter journey. As disciples, we may have doubts and fears – we must have faith. We will leave this upper room, in communion with each other to bring and be Church to the World.



We continue to pray now for this devoted shepherd of the Church. Guided by Pope Francis' pastoral example, may the Church continually make progress in charity, imitating more perfectly Christ's merciful love in all we think, say, and do." (Bishop Barry Kestout)


