

A Reflection on the Fourth Sunday of Easter By Fr. Eric Asamoah

Today, the 4th Sunday of Easter is called Good Shepherd Sunday. In each of the three lectionary cycles, the Gospel is taken from the tenth chapter of the Gospel of John. This chapter of John's Gospel follows Jesus' healing of the man born blind and the rejection of this miracle by Jewish leaders who question Jesus' authority to heal.

Jesus responds to the authenticity of his authority by calling himself the Good Shepherd. This metaphor is deeply rooted in the pastoral culture of the ancient Near East, where shepherds were responsible for the well-being of their flocks.

Throughout Scripture, God's desire to shepherd His people is a testament to His unwavering love and commitment. By referring to Himself as the Good Shepherd Jesus reveals himself as God to the Pharisees, but they fail to understand Him. Hence this declaration not only affirms Jesus' divine role as the Shepherd of Israel but also expands the metaphor to include His sacrificial love and redemptive mission.

God's desire to shepherd His people reflects His intimate involvement in their lives, His commitment to their welfare, and His leadership in guiding them toward righteousness. One of the most direct references is found in Psalm 80:2; "O Shepherd of Israel, lend an ear, you who guide Joseph like a flock! Seated upon the cherubim, shine forth".

Jesus, our Good Shepherd, gave His life for us on the cross. He knows each one of us intimately and by name. And when we learn the voice of our Shepherd by spending time with Him and through listening to His voice in Scripture, He leads us. Listening to Jesus is portrayed as a defining characteristic of His true disciples.

It is Jesus' voice which calls us to greater concern for each other and for building a community of trusting relationships so all can benefit. To listen well is to suspend judgement of others, to resist the temptation to demonize those we disagree with, and to try to discern and understand with an open heart. As Jesus knows and cares for us, so should we know and care for each other.. When we actively listen, we not only learn but we form community, and we become families to each other with the Good Shepherd as our head. Bless your hearts.


