### **Nourished by the Sacraments**



#### A Reflection on the Sixth Sunday of Easter By Fr. Eric Asamoah

As our celebration of the Easter season is coming to an end, the liturgy reminds us that Jesus remains with us through the Holy Spirit, who teaches us everything we need to know, reminds us of all that Jesus taught, and brings us peace. Jesus our Master returns to the Father, which should fill the hearts of believers with peace, especially in the light of Jesus' promise of sending the Holy Spirit whose other name is the Paraclete, that is, the Comforter. This Comforter leads us along the way to eternal union with the Blessed Trinity: Father, Son, Holy Spirit.

As Christians, there are so many intrigues, perplexities, and dilemmas that we must contend with within our world today. Only those who pay attention to the Holy Spirit understand these and where they are leading us to. So, this time calls for a special relationship with the Holy Spirit. At no time in the history of the world is the need to listen to the Holy Spirit more important than our own time.

God's Holy Spirit comes to us as teacher and guide, not only regarding matters of doctrine in the case of the Church's magisterium, but also as regarding situations of daily life, which require light and strength, in order to make concrete decisions. In the first reading and the whole of Acts of the Apostles, the Apostles did not make any decisions without consulting the Holy Spirit. Also, they could not carry out any severe mission without the Holy Spirit. "The Holy Spirit and we have decided," they said. They concluded the meeting in the first reading in this way: ... "It is the decision of the Holy Spirit and of us not to place on you any burden beyond these necessities, namely, to abstain from meat sacrificed to idols, from blood, from meats of strangled animals, and from unlawful marriage. If you keep free of these, you will be doing what is right..."

This decision inspired by the Holy Spirit becomes one of the earliest doctrines ever enacted by the early Church. By prioritizing a relationship with the Holy Spirit, we can receive wisdom, discern God's will, and be empowered to fulfill our purpose in the world.


