A Reflection on Trinity Sunday By Deacon John Kren

On this Trinity Sunday, a very happy and restful Fathers' Day to all fathers. I encourage you to be extra careful as you barbecue tonight.

The Easter season ended last week, and we entered Ordinary time. Today, though we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity. Coming out of Easter, we have the opportunity to stop and meditate on this central mystery of our faith that we encountered in the Easter season. We met all the characters, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit - all in one, all separate, each an individual -- a mystery.

It is a mystery but does that necessarily mean it is unknowable, and we should not try. Anyone who watches a TV series will gain insight into how the culprit is unveiled show after show. Certainly, for us one of the persons of this Divine mystery doesn't think so. When we step back from all the fancy church language, what we find is what we learned during Easter. God so loved the world, that He gave his only Son, and sent the Holy Spirit to be with us. It is the essence of God's love for us, which is so great that He gave His only Son. It is built on relationships, and the love that exists between the three Persons and in their relationship. Their unity, but also in their individuality, is the relationship, the message that, all of us, young and old, rich and poor alike long to hear, a message that so many in our world today are desperate to hear and to experience.

In the trinitarian relationship you and I can see true and intimate love and hear the message that we are desperate to hear in our lives. That we are loved unconditionally.

The truth of our being is written in the very marrow of our being, we need community.

We need each other. We yearn for company, for understanding, for love, for human affection, for warmth, for a gentle hand, a consoling smile. We long for love and respect. We hope for relationship and so on this Trinity Sunday, this solemnity, it is one that should stand out.

It reminds us that this great dogma. It is the outcome of our faith. The Trinity gives us insight that God is Love. God is here.




